

## CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION for courses

- §1 Scope and basis of contract
- (1) The following terms and conditions apply to all contracts concluded between you as a participant and the course organiser Tanzhologie Studio Corinna Janson (see imprint) regarding course participation.
- (2) All agreements made between the participant and the organiser in connection with these contracts result from these terms and conditions, our booking confirmation and our declaration of acceptance.
- §2 Conclusion of contract; prices; payment
- (1) The contract between the parties is concluded in the following way: The participant makes an offer to the organiser by sending the organiser a registration. The organiser shall contact the participant within a reasonable period of time.
- (4) Participant places are allocated according to studio capacity.
- §3 Liability regulations, liability insurance obligation
- (1) Claims for damages by the participant are excluded. Excluded from this are claims for damages arising from injury to life, limb or health or from the breach of essential contractual obligations as well as liability for other damages based on an intentional or grossly negligent breach of duty by the organiser, its legal representatives or vicarious agents. Essential contractual obligations are those whose fulfilment is necessary to achieve the objective of the contract.
- (2) In the event of a breach of essential contractual obligations, the organiser shall only be liable for the foreseeable damage typical of the contract if this was caused by simple negligence, unless it is a matter of claims for damages arising from injury to life, limb or health.
- (3) The restrictions of paragraphs 1 and 2 also apply in favour of the legal representatives and vicarious agents of the organiser if claims are asserted directly against them.
- §4 Cancellation regulations, case of non-participation

Tanzhologie Studio - Corinna Janson as organiser is granted a right of withdrawal according to the following conditions:

In case of force majeure or too few participants, the organiser is entitled to cancel a seminar. In this case, the organiser is obliged to inform the participant



immediately; otherwise, the organiser and the participant are released from their obligations and the participant will receive a full refund of their participation fee without delay. With regard to any damage arising from the cancellation of the course, the exclusion of liability agreed in these Conditions of Participation shall apply.

- §5 Consequences of non-participation; resale or transfer of the participant's place
- (1) In the event of non-participation, the deposit or participant fee paid can only be refunded on a goodwill basis.
- (2) The participant place is bound to the person of the registered participant. The participant is therefore not entitled to resell the participant place himself/herself or to sell or transfer it to third parties for commercial resale by them without the written consent of the organiser.
- §7 Data protection, use of image and sound material
- (1) By concluding the contract, the participant consents to the storage and use of personal data provided by him/her for the purpose of processing the contract. This includes, for example, the sending of e-mails by the organiser. This consent is revocable. The stored data will not be passed on to third parties. The treatment of the data provided shall be in accordance with the applicable legal provisions.
- (2) The participant gives his/her revocable consent for the organiser to publish picture and sound recordings of him/her from the course.
- (3) The granting of permission for the publication of image and sound material relating to public performances within the framework of the event is a prerequisite for active participation.
- §8 Final provision, applicable law
- (1) German law shall apply to all contracts concluded in accordance with these conditions.
- (2) These Terms and Conditions of Participation shall remain binding in their remaining parts even if individual points are legally invalid.
